The 968 Series

The 968 series features a trim-sized mortise case for use in door thicknesses of one inch or better. The petite size of the mortise case (3 1/2" by 2"), makes the 968 the ideal solution for narrow door openings. The series consists of a passage latch, privacy lock for head doors, as well as a deadlocking latch for key controlled security. The variety of functions is complemented by the availability of three separate trimset designs, which come in three standard finishes: polished brass (MP), polished chrome (MPCH) and matte chrome (MMCH).

The 968ZK

The latest addition to the 968 Series is the 968ZK featuring a deadlocking function like the 968 but with a key cylinder and thumbturn (pictured right).



The 928 Series

The 928 Series offers a similar, though totally finished lock case for rim-mounted application. The rim application offers an appealing solution to latching and locking doors of less than one inch thickness (particularly thin plexiglass doors, such as showers). As with all Schwepper marine hardware, the 928 series is constructed of high quality brass and marine grade stainless. The series offers the same three functions as the 968, with two separate trimsets and the three standard finishes.



928ZK

The latest addition to the 928 Series is the 928ZK which also has a deadlocking function like the 928 but with a key cylinder and thumbturn (pictured below).



Sliding Door Locks



Sturdy and well-built, the 969 and 3381 sliding door locks provide secure latching and locking for all sliding door needs. Along with heavy gauge stainless springs, the cast brass latches, hubs and locking mechanisms make the latching action a firm and smooth one. Each comes equipped with standard trimsets, though alternate trim may be used to coordinate the set with other hardware throughout the boat.

Also available is the 1069 series, a sliding door lock with a recessed latch, shown with the 4969 trim (pictured right). The 4969 trim can also be used with the 969 sliding door lock.

Our newest model is the 3801SZ stainless steel sliding door lock – see back page for details.



The 4040 Series

The 4040 Series is by far our most popular unit, offering a full-size mortise case for application in door thicknesses of as little as one inch. The thin case, a mere 5/8 of an inch, provides for easy installation. The series offers passage, privacy and locking functions, complemented by a variety of interchangeable trim styles. The 4040 Series is now standard with an anti-vibration latch. Polished brass, polished chrome, matte chrome and 24K gold plating are available.

The 3200 Series

The 3200 Series offers a full size mortise unit (3" x 6" x 5/8") and is available with a wide variety of trim styles. Due to its superior spring structure it is an excellent choice for use with heavy custom designer levers. It is also the preferred choice for exterior and engine room doors as well as crew quarters due to its heavy construction and durability. The 3200 series is available with both a standard flat latch well as an anti-friction latch. This specially constructed, three-piece latch fits securely inside the strike plate – thereby eliminating any rattling noises caused by vibration when the vessel is underway.

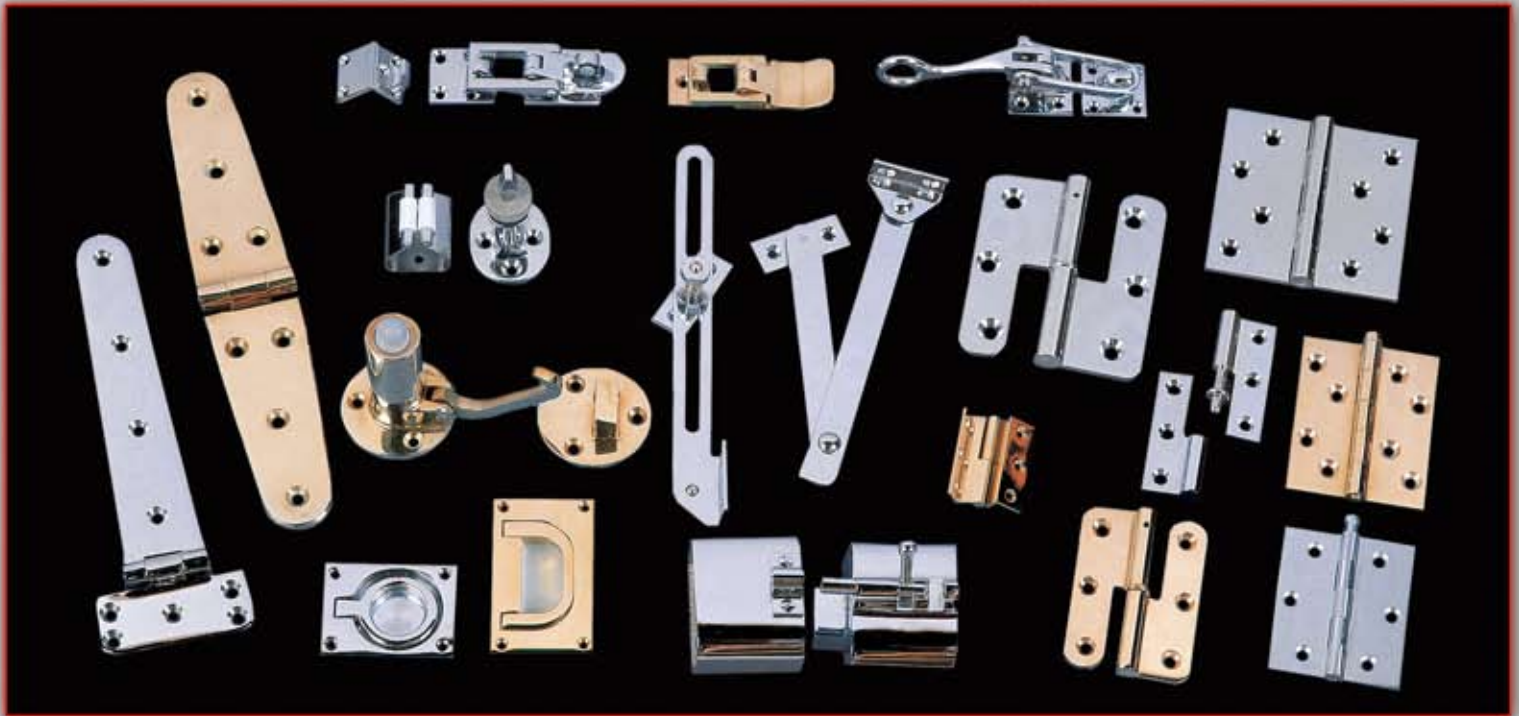

While the 3200 Series is available in polished brass, matte chrome and polished chrome, the 3800 Series offers the same mortise locks in stainless steel. Brushed stainless finish is standard, polished stainless is also available. The 3811Z, for swinging doors, is also available with an anti-panic function for hotel rooms with a fixed knob on the outside. The 3801SZ is our newest model for sliding doors with a stainless steel faceplate, hook & mortise case. It has the same cutouts as the 3811Z.
